

## COOKIE POLICY – Extended Cookie Information Notice

### What are cookies

Cookies are small text files that websites visited by users send to their devices, where they are stored and then transmitted back to the same websites on subsequent visits. So-called “third-party” cookies are instead set by a website different from the one the user is currently visiting. This occurs because a website may contain elements (such as images, maps, sounds, or specific links to web pages on other domains, etc.) that are hosted on servers other than that of the visited website. Cookies are used for various purposes, including: performing electronic authentication, monitoring user sessions, storing information about specific configurations related to users accessing the server, saving preferences, and more. Below you will find all the information about the cookies installed through this website, as well as the necessary instructions on how to manage your preferences regarding them.

### Examples of other technologies

#### Local Storage

Local Storage is a technology used to optimize browsing that does not collect data about the preferences expressed by the user (e.g., it stores a code that identifies the user’s session after login, to prevent the user from having to enter a username and password on every profile page when accessing restricted areas).

#### Tracking pixel

A “tracking code” or “monitoring code” is a small piece of code released by certain systems for the purpose of being implemented in others in order to track certain data relating to the user and their browsing session or the opening of emails, in a manner that is completely transparent to the user. The data that may be tracked can vary widely, such as the day and time, geographic location, the type of device used for browsing, up to more complex tracking pixels that monitor the amount spent on a purchase order and other information useful for the marketing departments of the companies that use them.

#### Plugins

A plugin is a program that interacts with another program in order to extend or enhance its original functionality. The most commonly used plugins are those of social networks, which allow users, for example, to follow a page or a social profile with a single click, indicate with a click that they liked a web content, and share it on their own social network profile, etc.

#### Widgets

A widget is a graphical user interface component of a program, designed to facilitate user interaction with the program itself. The most commonly used widgets are those of social networks, which allow users to easily open social networks in a separate browser window. These services enable interactions with social networks or other external platforms directly from the pages of a website. Any interactions and information acquired by the website are subject to the privacy settings of the third party that created the aforementioned technologies.
